On page 43, “refer to wiring” should read “refer to as wiring”.

On page 87, there is a formatting error in the first line of the grammar. The correct grammar is:

<i>NounPhrase</i> → <i>Adjective NounPhrase</i>	<i>Adjective</i> → colorless
<i>NounPhrase</i> → <i>Noun</i>	<i>Adjective</i> → green
<i>VerbPhrase</i> → <i>Verb Adverb</i>	<i>Noun</i> → ideas
	<i>Verb</i> → sleep
	<i>Adverb</i> → furiously

On page 89, there is an extra → in the first line of the grammar. The correct grammar is:

<i>Sentence</i> → apple	<i>Sentence</i> banana
<i>Sentence</i> → apple	banana

On page 121, “Social Relationships” should be “Social Relations”.

On page 125, “those that don’t” should be “those that we don’t”.

On page 147, “weight_i” should be “weight_{ir}”.
